Our Model of Care

Many children globally live without any access to dental care during their young lives. Small cavities grow, causing pain and affecting a child's ability to sleep, eat, pay attention in school, and generally thrive.

GDR volunteers restore children to dental health and bright smiles. Children attend clinic and receive all needed dental care, oral health education, and a new toothbrush. Most importantly, they return to clinic every two years to ensure sustained dental health.

- 29 volunteer service trips

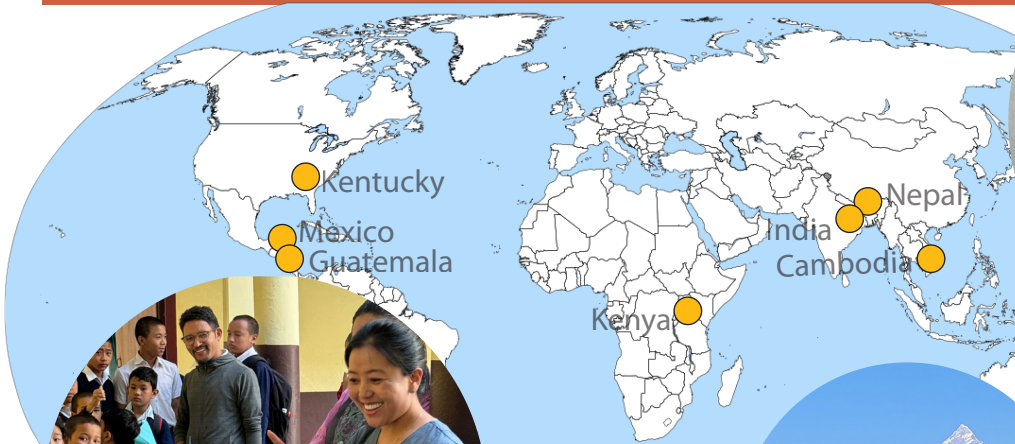
